Science Quiz Competition 2014-15**

The eight (8) **District Primary Schools Science quiz** has been scheduled for Monday, **January 26th – Friday 30th 2015** and the **National Independence Primary Science & Technology quiz for Wednesday February 18th 2014 at the CSA centre**. The theme for this year's Science activities is **“YOUNG INVENTORS BLAZING AN EXCITING TRAIL TOWARDS SUCCESS IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY”**.

The District competition will be organized in the same manner as the National Competition. Each Primary School within a District will have a team of three (3) students. Two (2) of the three students will participate in the competition, while the third will be on standby. The winning school from each District will qualify for the National competition.

Some of the benefits from participating in the science quiz include:

- promoting science at the Primary level;
- stimulating a renewed interest in Science and Technology in schools;
- acquiring useful knowledge for both local and external science Examinations.

Principals and science coordinators are encouraged to commence preparing their entire Grade fives (5) and not just two (2) or three (3) students for this event. All schools are urged to participate in the District competition and to qualify for the Independence National Primary School Science & Technology quiz competition.
